

Prepare your students for Ute Knowledge: STEM Kit

Recommended for Third through Fifth Grades

What to Expect

This program will begin with full classroom discussion on the floor around a map of Colorado. The map is the size of a large classroom rug. Then students will complete activities in small groups. Small group activities can take place on the floor or at desks, whatever is easier for your classroom. **Please think in advance for where you would like students to be.** Finally, students will meet again on the floor around the large map for final discussion and wrap up questions. We can also do this program in a library or gymnasium space if necessary.

Before the Presentation

- 1) **Divide your students into 6 groups.** These are the small groups that students will work in to complete a series of matching and then challenge activities during the program. There are six different themes. Each student will get to complete 2-4 during the program.
- Consider completing a pre-lesson, which you can access by visiting our <u>Teacher</u> <u>Resources</u> page. This aspect of the program is still under construction, but we have some options for you to consider. Pre-lessons are not necessary for students to enjoy the presentation.

During the Presentation:

- Teachers can help museum instructors by helping supervise small group work and helping students answer review questions at the end of each station.
- Instructors may need assistance with monitoring and adjusting class behavior. GHM&P staff are unfamiliar with your students' backgrounds and disciplinary protocols, therefore *teachers must remain in the classroom for the duration of the program.*

Payment

- A 25% non-refundable deposit is required within 30 days of receiving your invoice to hold your reservation. Programs scheduled within 30 days of booking do not require a deposit.

- If a program is cancelled less than 30 days prior to your scheduled program, the museum will refund the final payment minus the 25% deposit. The museum will work with you to reschedule if there are open options on our outreach calendar for the current school year.
- If a program is cancelled due to inclement weather, the museum will work with the school to reschedule to another open date on our outreach calendar for the current school year.
