**Re:** Deaccession recommendation

---

Golden History Museum & Park piloted a Legacy Collection Inventory in winter 2019 designed to reappraise the existing collection on hand when the City of Golden commenced museum management in 2010. Now a museum priority, project goals include conducting a complete physical inventory of everything housed at offsite museum storage, updating and improving records, rehousing artifacts when necessary, and finally, reappraising all artifacts for relevancy to museum mission and scope of collection. Now nearly three years into the project, curatorial staff have inventoried approximately 10,236 artifacts (about 70% of 14,633 cataloged artifacts currently in collection). *Note: this artifact count includes all collection inventory activity and is not limited to the Legacy Collection Inventory.* At this pace we anticipate completion in 2025.

I recommend deaccessioning the attached list of 110 artifacts from the permanent collection. (This is the seventh in a series since 2019.) Per policy, *Deaccessioning of any object in the GHM&P Permanent Collection will be recommended by GHM&P curatorial staff after careful consideration of the object as it relates to the GHM&P mission statement and scope of collections.*

My reasons for deaccession drawn from collection policy are as follows:

- 1. Non-relevance: Any artifact no longer relevant or compatible with the Museum's mission statement may be deaccessioned. These circumstances may arise from wholesale acquisitions of the past, the reorganization of or a change of emphasis within GHM&P.*
- 2. Quality: Any artifact of poor quality which occupies valuable storage space may be approved for deaccessioning.*

Highlights from this selection slated for deaccession include:

Square grand piano with stool, sheet music, magazines, books, a bible, kitchen & household tools, dental tools, a typewriter, adding machine, oil lamp, and pharmacy tools. For all these objects, available donor information documents were either nonexistent, listed donors as coming from outside of the Golden community, or the actual items lack any historical significance.

Curatorial staff will offer relevant items to museum education staff for possible program reuse. Upon final deaccession approval, items will be sold at public sale through Corbett's Auction House, and the proceeds deposited in the restricted escrow account for future acquisition and artifact conservation.

The Pelton grand piano was gifted to Golden Landmarks Association to furnish the Astor House Museum years ago. The museum obtained the piano from GLA in an artifact-grant exchange with the City in 2008. Per the agreement, this object would be returned to GLA if they wished. Staff has already contacted GLA who has expressed interest in having the piano back. After the deaccession period is over, the Museum would transfer the piano to GLA.
